**Course details**

- The course is affiliated to the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University, Chennai.
- The course commences from September 1, 2019.
- The Medium of Instruction is English.
- The duration of the course is two years of study period and one year of Internship (AERB Concurrence).

**Eligibility for admission**

Successful Completion of BSc Degree Course (with applicable Internship) in Radiotherapy Technology

Candidates who have submitted mark sheets with 'GRADES' should obtain the mark equivalent certificates from the examination authority and enclose a copy along with their mark sheets. In the case of candidates who have furnished the mark sheets of the qualifying examination only in 'GRADES' the minimum marks of the 'Grades' alone will be taken in to consideration.

Candidates who have passed any qualifying examination as stated above other than from the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University, Chennai, shall obtain an 'Eligibility Certificate' from the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University by remitting the prescribed fees along with the application form and required documents before seeking admission to the course. There is no upper age limit for admission

**General instructions**

1. Candidates should send the completed application with all the necessary documents to the Dean, Cancer Institute (WIA), Adyar, Chennai 600 020. In case of candidates in Government service or candidates being deputed by an Institution / Organization, the application should be made through the relevant proper channel.
2. All the entries in the application form must be legibly written by the candidate in his / her own handwriting.

3. An Account Payee Demand Draft dated not earlier than August 26, 2019, in favor of "Cancer Institute (WIA), Chennai – 20" for Rs. 250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) towards Registration Fee should be attached to each application. This fee will not be refunded under any circumstances, whether the candidate is considered for selection or not. Candidates are, therefore, advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they fulfil all the conditions for admission to the course prescribed as per regulations.
4. Xerox copies of the following documents / certificates should be enclosed in the same order:
  - a) Evidence of date of birth and nationality
  - b) Community Certificate, if applicable
  - c) **All** the mark sheets of the Secondary School Leaving Certificate and Higher Secondary Course Examinations and BSc Degree Course in Radiotherapy Technology
  - d) Transfer Certificate obtained after the completion of BSc Degree Course in Radiotherapy Technology
  - e) BSc Degree Certificate / Provisional Pass Certificate obtained from the University
  - f) Communication from the institution deputing the candidate, if any
  - g) 'No Objection Certificate' from the present employer, if any.
5. No document enclosed along with the application will be returned. Only Xerox copies of the certificates should be enclosed. The original certificates should be produced at the time of interview for verification.
6. Two recent conduct certificates (obtained within three months prior to the date of application) from responsible persons (in original)
7. A recent, color, passport-size photograph should be affixed on the first page of the application form in the space provided.
8. The selection of the candidate will be considered only when all the certificates / enclosures are in order. The original certificates once deposited on admission cannot and will not be released to them until they are considered to be no longer required by the Institute.
9. The application with all enclosures securely fastened should be sent by 'Registered Post with Acknowledgement Due' superscribed and addressed as follows:

The last date for the receipt of completed applications in the office of the Cancer Institute is September 07, 2019.

Applications which are incomplete or without the signature of the candidates or necessary enclosures and those received after the due date will be rejected summarily without any intimation to the candidate.

10. All candidates should report for a written examination on September 11, 2019, at their own expense. They should be present at the Auditorium, Dr S Krishnamurthi Campus, Cancer Institute (WIA), New No 38, Old No 18, Sardar Patel Road, Guindy, Chennai 600 036 (Near Gandhi Mandapam), at 10.00 am on that day. **Separate communication will not be sent regarding the place and time of the interview.**
11. A shortlist of candidates shall be prepared based on their academic performance and those candidates shall be called for an interview on September 12, 2019. They should report, at their own expense, to the Office of the Director (Administration), Second Floor, Lions Cancer Support Centre, Dr S Krishnamurthi Campus, Cancer Institute (WIA), New No 38, Old No 18, Sardar Patel Road, Guindy, Chennai 600 036 (Near Gandhi Mandapam), at 10.00 am on that day.
12. In the matter of selection, the decision of the Selection Committee shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained on the subject.
13. All candidates in Government service (State or Central) and candidates sponsored by autonomous institutions will be permitted for the written examination only if their applications are forwarded by the Government or sponsoring authority, as the case may be, officially. Advance copies will not entitle them to attend the written examination. They should produce, at the time of interview, a 'No Objection Certificate' from the Government or the sponsoring authority affirming that the candidate will be released for the course if and when selected.
14. Intimation will be sent only to the selected candidates and they should be prepared to join the course immediately on receiving the information of selection.
15. They shall register their names with the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University, through the Dean of the Cancer Institute (WIA), by submitting the prescribed application form for registration duly filled, along with the prescribed fee, a declaration in the format, to the Controller of Examinations of the University and all the original documents, within 3 Months from the cut-off date prescribed for the course for admission, i.e., September 30, 2019.

Admission to the above course is provisional and subject to the approval of the qualification of the individual candidates and the acceptance of the candidates for registration by the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University. Candidates who have not registered on the due date as specified above will not be admitted.

All candidates provisionally selected should undergo a medical examination, to assess the physical fitness of the candidate to undergo the course, prior to final confirmation of selection.

**16. University Fees:**

All candidates have to pay the required fees to the Tamil Nadu Dr MGR Medical University, through the Dean, Cancer Institute (WIA), from time to time.
